The MFC internship program is designed for students seeking placements for practicums, class projects, externally funded internships, and for-credit internships. The program is best suited for creative individuals interested in social justice, environmental justice, sustainability, human-centered design, public health, environmental science, and/or social enterprise. All internships are virtual, and MFC encourages applicants from any geographic location. Internships can begin at any time during the year. Our most common internships are the Communications Internship and the Management & Administrative Internship. Additional roles can be co-designed with prospective interns or practicum students.
